OPENING REMARKS

1. The request for leave of absence by Dr. A.N. Balchand, Dr. N. Mohanan and Dr. V.S. Sebastian from the meeting was granted by the Syndicate.
2. Dr. A. Mujeeb raised a point of order regarding leakage of deliberations taking place in the Syndicate meetings and opined that if the same is due to video recording, its confidentiality should be ensured. In this regard the Vice-Chancellor assured the members that the confidentiality of the meetings has always been maintained till now and stated that nobody has access to the recording other than the Vice-Chancellor.

631.03 *	<p>Budget proposal for the year 2016-17.</p> <p>The Syndicate considered the budget proposals of the University for the financial year 2016-17 presented by Dr. K. Poulose Jacob, Pro Vice Chancellor, along with the recommendations of the Syndicate Sub Committee and the Statutory Finance Committee.</p> <p>The Syndicate observed that though the overall funds position shows a surplus of ₹23.41 crores, this is not a matter of consolation as the surplus is on account of plan funds which are earmarked for specific purposes and cannot be used to fund non-plan expenditure, where there is shortage. The funds deficit in the self-financing sector was also viewed with much concern.</p> <p>All members present actively participated in the ensuing discussions and made suggestions, including measures for enhancing revenue and reducing expenses. These are summarized below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <i>The Report & recommendations made by the Sub-Committee of the Syndicate, which looked into the financial & other aspects in connection with de-linking of recognized technical institutions from CUSAT, which was approved by the Syndicate in its 629th meeting</i>

needs to be taken up for implementation in right earnest. The recommendations therein cover measures for raising revenue and controlling expenditure.

2. Considering the precarious financial position of SOE, CUCEK and KMSME University should initiate steps to take up the matter with the State Government for seeking financial support.
3. Introduce evening M.Tech programmes in as many areas and in as many departments as possible. Fee structure should be on 'self-financing' basis.
4. Possibility of introducing integrated PG courses in emerging and job-oriented areas may be considered. Fee structure should be on 'self-financing' basis.
5. Possibility of introducing short-term, job-oriented Certificate & Diploma courses can also be considered. These may include courses in areas like Multimedia; Journalism; Film related subjects etc. Due importance may also be accorded to the Language Faculties. Fee structure for all such courses should be on 'self-financing' basis.
6. Introducing MOOC (Massive Open Online Courses) in as many areas as possible. Here also, the fee structure should be on 'self-financing' basis. A separate Cell shall be formed for implementing the same.
7. Tapping Alumni for funds needs to be given a greater thrust.
8. Likewise, a more meaningful & productive collaboration with industries and efforts to increase consultancy assignments by the teaching faculty to be made.
9. University also needs to try to attract more foreign students like in many other Universities in the country. For this, our overall governance style needs to be improved and made student-friendly.
10. To compensate for loss of revenue due to de-linking of Engineering colleges, possibility of recognizing Science colleges may be explored.
11. Increasing the rates of water charges from occupants of staff quarters and Student hostel inmates need to be examined after taking into account the existing rates being levied by the KWA.
12. To reduce the expenditure on water charges, the new pond under construction near the Athidhi Bhavan needs to be completed & commissioned as early as possible. This is also important to obtain

financial support from the UGC, as it is part of the XII plan proposals.

- 13. To supplement the above, rain water harvesting may also be taken up in a big way.*
- 14. Likewise, to reduce the expenditure on electricity charges, possibility of tapping solar power needs to be seriously examined. Proposal for funding may be submitted to the National Solar Mission, which is promoting this initiative. Also, since funding for solar power is very much likely under the ST Radar project, this may also be immediately pursued.*
- 15. It is also desirable that a comprehensive Energy Audit is carried out in all the campuses.*
- 16. Many Centres are being established from time to time. While some of them are able to obtain external financial support, some still continue to depend on University State plan funding. Hence, all such Centres need to be urged to tap external sources for funds for its sustenance. An annual target for income generation may be fixed for all Centres.*
- 17. Waste disposal has also assumed serious proportions. Steps need to be initiated to recycle/ dispose such waste.*
- 18. It is high time for the University to put in place the concept of 'Performance Audit' in order to promote efficiency. Higher functional efficiency automatically translates into cost savings. To facilitate performance assessment, a set of KPIs (Key Performance Indicators) needs to be developed. This audit may be made applicable to both departments & staff. The best performing department as assessed by the end of each year could be made eligible for appropriate additional funds allocation in the following year.*

A Sub Committee may be constituted to submit a report with recommendations for implementation. Sri. George Paul, Dr.Zakkariya, Dr. Balchand A.N. and Sri.R.S Sasikumar may be the members of this Sub Committee, with Sri.George Paul as the Convener.

- 19. As a great deal of external financial support by various Ministries of the Central Government is available for various projects/ purposes and in order to further encourage & promote research activities in the University, the need for a proactive and efficient Planning Division is a necessary prerequisite. Hence steps may be*

	<p><i>initiated to strengthen the Planning Division appropriately.</i></p> <p><i>20. Taking into account the considerable expenditure being incurred annually towards Medical reimbursement, possibility of introducing a medical Insurance Scheme for employees may be explored.</i></p> <p><i>21. Considering the high-value of the prestigious Endowment instituted in the name of Dr.M.V.Pylee, former Vice Chancellor, the University may consider making an annual contribution to the corpus of this Endowment in order to ensure its attractiveness & continuance and retain its financial viability.</i></p> <p><i>22. Given the fact that University is moving towards implementing a common time-table across all academic departments, steps may be initiated to construct a Smart Lecture theatre/Classroom with a 120-140 seating capacity. It should be centrally located with fairly convenient access to all academic departments. It should have all related features on the lines of the IIT/IIM model. Steps may also be initiated in 2016-17 to obtain special funding support for this from the State Government under any appropriate scheme.</i></p> <p><i>23. Since the upgradation of CUSAT to IEST has not yet been materialized, CUSAT should in parallel make all possible efforts to enhance its performance in all spheres of activity and strive to elevate itself to an institution of national status even otherwise.</i></p> <p><i>The Vice Chancellor thanked all the members for their valuable suggestions and assured the House to implement as many of the above suggestions as possible, subject to availability of funds wherever called for.</i></p> <p><i>The Syndicate thereafter resolved to approve the Revised Estimates for the current year 2015-16 as projected in the budget proposal and the Budget Estimates for 2016-17. Also resolved to further fine-tune the Revised Estimate figures for 2015-16 based on the trend of expenditure during March 2016, in order to minimize the variance between RE and the likely actuals, and adjust the difference in the Lumpsum Provision figures without disturbing the approved Budget outlay figures for 2016-17.</i></p>
