REPORTING OF THE VICE-CHANCELLOR

The Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the new members nominated to the Syndicate to the meeting.

	The Syndicate considered the budget proposals of the University for the financial year 2015-16 presented by Dr. Poulose Jacob, Pro-Vice-Chancellor along with the recommendations the Statutory Finance Committee.
	In the discussions that followed the following suggestions were made.
	 Introduce Faculty Recharge Programme. Construction of Quarters for non-teaching staff – Sections Officers and above.

- 3. Merge all funds to Cochin University Fund (no separate fund for self-financing sector).
- 4. As part of resource mobilization the University may consider the following:-
 - (i) Start new courses in the existing departments
 - (ii) Course sponsored by agencies like NORKA
 - (iii) New courses with industry participation
 - (iv) To give recognition for more institutions including Arts and Sciences Colleges
 - (v) To collect refundable deposit from B. Tech students
 - (vi) To rationalize the fees for all B.Tech programmes
- 5. It was also suggested that a definite portion of the funds generated through self-financing programmes should be set apart for infrastructure development of the concerned Department/School.
- 6. In order to speed up the process of upgrading CUSAT into IIEST a delegation should meet the concerned Ministers/officials of the State as well as Centre.

In the concluding remarks the Vice-Chancellor assured that the above suggestions will be well taken care of and also requested Sri. M. Sherif, Joint Secretary, Higher Education Department to do necessary follow up at the Centre, since he visits Delhi quite often on official purpose.

After detailed discussions and deliberations, the Syndicate resolved to approve the Budget Estimates for the year 2015-16.

The honorable member Sri. Sunny P Jose, expressed his strong disagreement for not discussing the Budget with the conveners of various standing committees of the Syndicate before finalizing the same and gave the same in writing (Appendix-I).

Dr. K A Zakkariya also expressed his displeasure for not discussing the Budget with the conveners of various standing committees of the Syndicate before finalizing the same.
