ITEM No. 101.01. CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE SYNDICATE HELD ON 6-5-1978 AND 12-5-1978.

Resolved that the Minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 6-5-1978 be confirmed.

Resolved further that the Minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 12-5-1978 be confirmed subject to the following emendations:

a) Item No. 10.01 wrongly typed be corrected as Item No. 100.01.

b) The subjects shown against Barrister Pavithran A. K., Shri P. S. Achuthan Pillai and Shri P. G. Krishnan in Item No. 100.18 be corrected as International Law against Barrister Pavithran, Criminal Law against Shri P. S. Achuthan Pillai and Labour Law against Shri P. G. Krishnan.

c) The initials of Dr. Nambiar under Item No. 100.20 be corrected as "K. P. P." instead of "C. K. K." and the word "Managing" be inserted before the word "Director."

d) The last sentence viz. "the existing vacancies filled up" in the first Resolution under Item No. 100.31 be deleted, and the following sentence substituted:

"The Rank list prepared by the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Staff and Establishment be published which would be valid for two years from the date of publication".

The second Resolution in the item 100.31 be deleted.

ITEM No. 101.02. REPORT BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR ON IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS IN THE UNIVERSITY SINCE THE LAST MEETING.

The Vice-Chancellor reported that:

a) He had been to New Delhi for the meeting of the Vice-Chancellors on 30th and 31st of May. One of the main points of discussion at the meeting was the allocation of the

Sixth Plan funds for higher education. Eventhough the Sixth Plan would be more than double theise of the Fifth Plan, the allocation for higher education would be less than that for the Fifth Plan period. For the purpose of allocation of grants to the Universities, the Universities would be divided into three categories viz. (i) the developed Universities which would get grants only for the new departments started during the Fifth Plan (ii) the developing Universities which would be given sufficient money for further development, and (iii) under-developed Universities which would be given more grant than the other Universities. It was also the consensus of the Conference that every University must take up extension work.

b) The Dean, Faculty of Technology has been put in full additional charge of the Department of Ship Technology until other arrangements are made.

Resolved that the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor be ratified.

c) Dr. Vajravelu, a qualified Naval Architect, had been to the University for a discussion with the Vice-Chancellor and the Pro-Vice Chancellor. He was willing to be considered for appointment as a Visiting Professor.

Resolved that the Vice-Chancellor be authorised to negotiate further and appoint him as a Visiting Professor on terms within the guidelines of the UGC.

d) Mr. B. Biswas who was an applicant for the post of Reader in Naval Architecture and who could not appear for the interview has written to the Registrar that he was out of Station at Calcutta and enquired whether he could now come for an interview.

The Syndicate authorised the Vice-Chancellor to call him for an interview and thereafter to consider him for appointment in the Department of Ship Technology.

e) A Scheme for cashew plantation in the vacant land in the Trikkakara Campus in collaboration with the Cashew

Development Corporation has been put up. It would be advantageous for the University to implement such a scheme. It was also suggested that atleast 500 avenue trees might be planted this year.

f) Visited the UGC Office in New Delhi. It was gathered that the second phase of the Report of the Visiting Committee of the UGC would be considered only after furnishing a statement of what had been achieved during the first phase of the schemes and it was likely that the UGC would be sanctioning the second phase of the Schemes by October 1978 at the latest.

g) Met the Ambassador of the GDR at New Delhi and discussed with him the Ship Technology Project.

ITEM No. 101.03. ORGANISING A SHORT-TERM COURSE IN FRENCH AT THE RUBBER RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF INDIA, KOTTAYAM.

The Syndicate considered the request of the Director, RRIL, Kottayam and the proposals of the Head of the Department of Foreign Languages for the conduct of a short term course in French at the Rubber Research Institute of India, Kottayam, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic Matters.

Resolved that a short-term course in French be conducted at the Rubber Research Institute of India, Kottayam on the following conditions:

a) Shri Jose P. Thomas be the Course Director to conduct the classes for the RRIL Officers for the entire duration of the course.

b) He might be paid TA and DA admissible to him under the Rules.

c) No P. T. Teacher need be appointed.

d) In his absence, he might hand over charge of the Department to the senior most teacher in his department.

e) Shri Jose P. Thomas might make arrangements for admission in consultation with the Director, RRIL.

f) The completed application in original might be sent to the University along with prescribed fees.

g) The course shall be called as 'Certificate Course in French' and not as 'Post-Graduate Certificate Course'

h) The proposed course might be for 10 weeks and commence not later than 20th June 1978.

i) University might hold examination at the end of the course.

j) A certificate might be awarded to those who successfully complete the course.

k) Only RRIL Officers need be admitted to the programme; no advertisement in the newspapers need be issued.

l) Fees shall be Rs. 300/- payable in one instalment.

Resolved further that the Vice-Chancellor be authorised to discuss the above conditions with Shri Jose P. Thomas and to make alterations if necessary and report the matter to the Syndicate.

ITEM No. 101.04. AMENDMENT TO REGULATIONS FOR M. A. DEGREE COURSE IN HINDI - FIXING UP OF THE DATE OF EFFECT AND PUBLICATION IN THE GAZETTE.

The Syndicate considered the proposal for publication of the Notification for amending the Regulations for M. A. Degree Course in Hindi and the question of fixing the date on which the amendment shall come into force, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic matters.

Resolved that the Notification for amending the Regulations for M. A. Degree Course as in Appendix. I be published and that the amendments be effective from the date of the decision of the Academic Council, viz. 13-3-1978. (Ac.)

ITEM No. 101.05. PROPOSALS FOR A DEPARTMENT OF MALAYALAM.

The Syndicate considered the Resolution adopted by the Samastha Kerala Sahitya Parishath forwarded by its Secretary, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic matters.

Resolved that the matter be deferred for consideration at the time of the setting up of the School of International Studies.

ITEM No. 101.06. S.N.D.P. YOGAM PLATINUM JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS AT QUILON - CONDUCT OF EXHIBITION.

The Syndicate considered the request of the General Convener, S.N.D.P. Yogam Platinum Jubilee for arranging a Pavillion of the Cochin University to project the specialised courses to the Public at the All India Exhibition proposed to be conducted in connection with the Platinum Jubilee celebrations of the Yogam, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic matters.

Resolved that the matter be discussed at the meeting of the Heads of Departments to assess to what extent the University could participate in the exhibition and their suggestions put up to the next meeting of the Syndicate.

ITEM No. 101.07. AMENDMENT TO REGULATIONS REGARDING ADMISSION TO RESEARCH DEGREES IN THE COCHIN UNIVERSITY FIXING UP OF DATE OF EFFECT AND PUBLICATION IN THE GAZETTE.

The Syndicate considered the proposal for the publication of the Notification for amending the Regulations regarding admission to Research Degrees, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic matters.

Resolved that the Publication of the Notification might wait till the revision of the Regulations relating to the Registration of students for the Research Degree was finalised.

ITEM No. 101.08. B. TECH. COURSE IN NAVAL ARCHITECTURE AND SHIP BUILDING - REMUNERATION TO THE MEMBERS OF THE STAFF IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS, ENGINEERING COLLEGE, TRICHUR.

The Syndicate considered the request of the Prof. of Mathematics, Engineering College, Trichur for the payment of 20% allowance to the teachers who attended the work relating to the Ship Technology course for the period from 21-10-1976 to 22-10-1977 when the post of II Gr. Professor of Mathematics created for the Ship Technology course was lying vacant, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic Matters.

Resolved that Dr. S. Vasudev, Director of Technical Education be requested to look into the question and to give a report to the Syndicate.

The Syndicate considered the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in admitting Sri M. R. Gopalakrishnan, Mundackal House, Nattassery, Kottayam to the 1st Semester of the Part-time Degree Course (Electrical Branch) in the Engineering College, Trichur in pursuance of the Judgement in O. P. No. 4572/77 filed in the High Court of Kerala.

Resolved that the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor be ratified.

ITEM No. 101.10 M. Sc. (BY RESEARCH) OCEANOGRAPHY QUALIFYING EXAMINATION - FACULTY OF MARINE SCIENCES - APPROVAL OF SYLLABUS.

The Syndicate considered the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in approving the Syllabus for the M. Sc. (by research) Oceanography qualifying examination in respect of Shri V. V. James working under the supervision of Dr. D. Srinivasan, Director, NPOL, Cochin as recommended by the Chairman, Board of Studies in Oceanography.

Resolved that the action taken by the Vice Chancellor be ratified.

ITEM No. 101.11. ISSUANCE OF RANK CERTIFICATE.

The Syndicate considered the proposal for the issuance of rank certificates to those candidates who do not pass their examination in the first chance, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic matters.

Resolved that the matter be placed before the Inter University Consultative Committee for evolving a common pattern for all the Universities in Kerala.

ITEM No. 101.12. UNIVERSITY TEACHING DEPARTMENTS - PERMANENT ADVANCE - RAISING OF.

The Syndicate considered the requests of the Heads of Departments for enhancement of the permanent advance and suggestions put up by the Office thereafter, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Finance, Works & Purchase.

Resolved that the following suggestions be approved.

a) The permanent advance of all the Teaching Departments be raised to Rs. 1000/-

b) The Heads of the Departments be permitted to open a separate Current Account in the State Bank of Travancore for keeping the advance and they be authorised to operate these accounts for purpose of meeting their day to day requirements. The transactions in this account should be reflected in the Cash Book of the Departments also.

c) The permanent Advance be recouped by the Heads of the Departments periodically.

d) On no account, the expenditure under a Minor Head under Contingencies and other Charges should exceed the Budget provision and no expenditure should be incurred in anticipation of any diversion from any other Head of Account.

e) The Expenditure from the Permanent Advance should be fully recouped before the end of the financial year without fail so that the total expenditure for the year might be reflected in the Annual Accounts of the University.

f) The Heads of the Departments be permitted to purchase Stores and other items without calling for quotation upto Rs. 200/- at a time.

JUNIOR ENGINEER / SCIENTIST.

- A first class Bachelor's Degree in Engineering with specialisation in Electronics or Instrumentation or its equivalent in Instrumentation Engineering.
- Minimum of 3 years experience as an Instrumentation Engineer in Industry/Defence Organisation/Instrumentation and Service Laboratory/Research and Development Laboratory.

Resolved further that the question of filling of the posts of Technicians be taken up after filling up of the above posts. (Ad)

thesis submitted by Shri M. Sabir, and that the expert with Sl. No. 1 be the Chairman of the Board of Examiners.

Resolved further that, in case the above experts are not available, the experts with Sl. Nos. 3 & 4 be considered.

The Syndicate considered the request of the Principal, Engineering College, Trichur for the administrative sanction for the purchase of Microwave Laboratory kit required for the Electrical Engineering Department at a cost of Rs. 55,000/- plus S.T. Excise Duty and other incidental expenses.

Resolved that the Principal, Engineering College, Trichur be permitted to purchase Microwave Kit required for the Electrical Engineering Department of the College at a cost of Rs. 55,000/- excluding S. T., Excise duty and other incidental expenses, as per the Stores Purchase Rules.

ITEM No. 101.26. CONSTRUCTION OF RESEARCH VESSEL- EXECUTION OF SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT-REG.

The Syndicate noted that there was an 'Escalation Clause' in the agreement executed between the University and the Director, CIFT for construction of a Research Vessel and as such it was not necessary to execute a supplementary agreement of Rs. 75,000/- made by the University as per the decision of the Syndicate held on 15-4-1975.

Resolved that no supplementary agreement need be executed in respect of the payment of Rs. 75,000/- to the CIFT.

ITEM No. 101.27. APPOINTMENT TO THE TEACHING POSTS.

The Syndicate considered the recommendations of the Boards of Appointment along with the connected records for appointments to the following teaching posts in the University.

i) LECTURER IN MICROBIOLOGY (INDUSTRIAL) IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MARINE SCIENCES.

The report of the Board of appointment that, there was no suitable candidate for this post was noted.

Resolved that the post be readvertised.

ii) LECTURER IN MICROBIOLOGY (MARINE) IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MARINE SCIENCES.

The Syndicate noted that the Board of Appointment had recommended two persons for consideration for appointment to this post but they did not possess the basic qualification Prescribed.

Resolved that the post be readvertised.

iii) LECTURER IN FISHERY ECONOMICS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL FISHERIES.

Resolved that Shri. Ramakrishnan Korakandy who was found suitable by the Board of Appointment be appointed as Lecturer in Fishery Economics in the Department of Industrial Fisheries on an initial pay of Rs. 600/- p.m. in the scale of pay of Rs 600-40-800-50-1100-50/2-1250.

iv) LECTURER IN CHEMISTRY IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MARINE SCIENCES.

Resolved that Dr. Jacob Chacko who was recommended as suitable by the Board of Appointment be appointed as

Lecturer in Chemistry in the Department of Marine Sciences on an initial pay of Rs. 600/- p.m. in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-800-50-1100-50/2-1250.

v) LECTURERS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SHIP TECHNOLOGY.

The Syndicate noted that the Board of Appointment had recommended a panel of four candidates - two each for Material Science and Solid Mechanics, for appointment as Lecturers in the Department of Ship Technology.

Resolved that the following candidates be appointed in the Department of Ship Technology against the two advertised vacant posts.

1. Shri. M. P. George as Lecturer (Material Science) on an initial pay of Rs. 600/-p.m. in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-800-50-1100-50/2-1250.

This post should have gone to a Scheduled caste candidate; but filled up with O. C. due to absence of any candidate belonging to Backward Communities.

2. Shri M. C. Issac as Lecturer (Solid Mechanics) on an initial pay of Rs. 1000-p.m. in the scale of Rs. 600-40-800-50/2-1250 as recommended by the Board of Appointment.

The Syndicate noted that there was another vacant post of Lecturer in Fluid Mechanics lying vacant in the Department of Ship Technology consequent on the resignation of Shri. Jose P. Lukose and that two posts of Professors and three posts of Readers in the Department could not be filled up so far due to paucity of qualified hands.

Resolved therefore that two of these vacant posts be filled up temporarily with the remaining two persons in the panel recommended by the Board of Appointment as follows:-

1. Shri. K. J. James as Lecturer against the vacant post of Lecturer (Fluid Mechanics) on an initial pay of Rs. 600/-p.m. in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-800-50-1100-50/2-1250.

2. Shri. G. Chandran Pillai as Lecturer against one of the vacant posts of Reader, on an initial pay of Rs. 600/- p.m. in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-800-50-1100-50/2-1250.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 24 (2) read with Section 34 (1) and (2) (a) of the Cochin University Act (Act 30 of 1971) the Academic Council makes the following amendment to Regulations for M. A. Degree Course in Hindi (Faculty of Humanities) published under Part IV Kerala Gazette No. 18 dated 4th May 1976 under Section 34 (3) of the said Act, Syndicate has approved this amendment and decided that it shall come into force with effect from 13-3-1978.

AMENDMENT

In Regulation 1. delete the words "50% in Hindi as" in the second sentence between "or" and "additional"

This Regulation as amended will read as follows:-

1 Admission to the Course.

Candidates for admission to the Master of Arts Hindi Degree Course shall be required to have passed the (B. A. or B. Sc) Degree examination of any of the Universities in Kerala or an Examination of any other University accepted by the Syndicate as equivalent thereto with Hindi as one of the subjects of study. The Candidates shall have secured not less than 45% marks in Hindi as main subject or additional or second language. Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates are eligible for a concession of 50% of the marks.

Admission will be based on the marks obtained in Hindi in the qualifying examination and interview.

Matters concerning admission procedure, payment of fees etc. will be prescribed by rules published in the Prospectus for the Course from time to time.
