## UNIVERSITY OF COCHIN MINUTES OF THE 139th MEETING OF THE SYNDICATE HELD ON 24-6-1980.

Before taking up the business of the day, the Syndicate resolved to place on record the services rendered to the University of Cochin by Shri. M. P. S. Pillai, who died of a heart attack on 22-6-1980, as a member of the Faculty of the Department of Ship Technology.

The Syndicate also resolved to condole the sudden demise on 24-6-1980 of Shri. V. V. Giri, former President of India and to place on record the services rendered by him to the nation.

Item No. 139.01: Confirmation of the minutes of the meeting of 137th and I38th Syndicate.

Resolved that the minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 3-5-1980 and 18-5-1980 be confirmed.

Arising out of the minutes of the 138th meeting, resolved that the Vice-Chancellor be authorised to issue the rules for the allotment and occupation of residential quarters of the University after incorporating any changes he considers necessary.

Item No. 139.02: Report by the Vice-Chancellor on important developments in the University since the last meeting of the Syndicate.

i) The constitutionality of the present meeting of the Syndicate has been questioned by four members of the Senate in a letter addressed to the Vice-Chancellor. In their opinion the Syndicate has to be reconstituted every four years and as no such re-constitution has taken place, there is no Syndicate in existence after 18-5-1980.

The matter was referred to the legal Adviser and in his view, according to the Cochin University Act the Syndicate is the chief executive body of the University and is so composed as to ensure continuity in administration. A four year term is fixed only in respect of the elected members of the Syndicate. It may be noted that the existence of any vacancy would not invalidate the proceedings of the Syndicate.

(ii) With the departure of Shri. M. P. S. Pillai the Department of Ship Technology is without a Head of the Department. The Department has been functioning for the

past several years without a well qualified and experienced Head. Even though all the seven posts of the Dopartment had been advertised twice, suitably qualified persons have not applied. Therefore it is necessary to take special steps to meet the situation.

Having considered all aspects of the matter, the Syndicate resolved that the Pro-Vice-Chancellor be requested to assume the headship of the Department until alternate arrangements are made.

Item No. 139.03: Registration for Research-Conversion to part-time - option for new Regulations.

The Syndicate considered the request of Shri. O. N. Muraleedharan and Smt. Jothy. P., registered for Ph. Dunder the old Regulations for conversion of their fulltime registration into part-time registration and the request of Smt. P. Jothy to come over to the new Regulation, along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic Matters.

Resolved that Shri. O. N. Muraleedharan and Smt. P. Jothy be required to apply afresh for registration under the new Regulations.

- (4) He be requested to execute a bond agreeing to serve the University for a period of 5 years on completion of his training at the Institute.

UNIVERSITY OF COCHIN
REGULATIONS FOR M. PHIL DEGREE COURSE

1. Admission to the course:-

Candidates for admission to the Master of Philosophy Degree shall be required to have passed a Master's degree Examination of any of the Universities in Kerala or an Examination accepted by the Syndicate as equivalent thereto and to have obtained a minimum of 50% of aggregate marks(or equivalent grade) in the Examination.

Teachers of a University Department or of colleges recognised by or affiliated to a statutory or "deemed" University having not less than three years of teaching experience irrespective of grade/marks obtained by them will also be leigible for admission to the course.

Admission will be based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations and such other criteria as may be decided from time to time.

## II. Course of study:-

The course work for M. Phil students shall be in accordance with the scheme prescribed by the respective M. Phil Committee.

#### **Duration:-**

The duration of the M. Phil course should normally be two semesters (One academic year).

#### Attendance:-

The minimum attendance required by a candidate will be 75% of the total number of working days.

## II'. Eligibility for the Degree:-

No candidate is eligible for the Degree of Master of Philosophy unless he she has successfully undergone the prescribed courses of study in a department/recognieds Institution of the University for not less than one academic year and has fulfilled all other requirements prescribed in the regulations from time to time.

## IV. M. Phil committee:-

- i. M. Phil programme shall be administered by the department concerned through its M. Phil Committee.
- ii. The M. Phil Committee will
  - a) recommend students for admission to the M. Phil course.
  - b) assign courses to the concerned teachers of the department.
  - c) organise seminars
  - d) make arrangements for evaluating performance of the M. Phil students at the seminars.
  - e) guide the students in the selection of topic for dissertation in consultation with recognised research supervisors of the Department.
  - f) recommend names of examiners for M. Phil dissertation to the University, on the recommend-dations of the Supervising teacher.

- g) recommend to the University for the award or otherwise of the degree to the students on the basis of assessment. M. Phil committee will finalise the results.
- three but not more than seven recognised supervising teachers of the Department nominated by the Vice-Chacellor in consultation with the Head of the Department who shall be the Chairman of the Committee, for each academic year.

#### V. Assessment:-

- (1) The course work including tests, seminars, term papers, assignments etc. will be evaluated as a continuous process. Students will also be required to submit on completion of the academic programme, a dissertation project report on a topic approved by the M. Phil Committee of the department and prepared under the guidance of a recognised supervising teacher of the University. The dissertation/project report shall be submitted normally on completion of the academic programme. In any case the dissertation shall be submitted within a maximum period of 24 months after the commencement of the course by the candidate.
- (ii) Each dissertation/project report shall be valued by a board of two external examiners. The Board of examiners shall be appointed by the University from a panel of at least five examiners forwarded by the M. Phil Committee, on the recommendations of the Supervising teacher.
- (iii) Viva-voce examination for each candidate shall be conducted by one of the external examiners appointed by the University and the Supervising teacher.

### VI. Pass Minimum:-

A candidate who secures not less than 50 per cent of the total marks separately for course work, dissertation and Viva-voce shall be declared to have passed the examination.

### VII. Classification:-

Candidates who secure 60 per cent and above of the grand total of marks will be placed in the 'A' gradel Candidates who have passed the examination with less than 60 per cent of the maximum marks will be placed in 'B' grade.

## VIII. Revision of regulations & Curriculum:-

The University may from time to time revise, amend or change the regulations. The Changes will take effect from the beginning of an academic year and shall not affect the students who are already undergoing the course.

## ORDER #

In the office Memorandum read above, Government of India have clarified that in the case of revised commutation of pension based on the revision of pension on account of treatment of a portion of D. A. as pay for the purpose of pensionary benefits and liberalisation of pension formula the pensioner will not be subjected to Medical Examination even if the date of retirement was more than one year earlier. It is further clarified therein that the commutation amount will also be based on the same age next birth day as was adopted for the original commutation of pension.

2. Government have considered the question of extending the above benefit to the State Government employees and

are pleased to order that pensioners who have commuted pension without being subjected to Medical Examination will be permitted to have further commutation of pension as per rules, consequent on the revision of pension under the orders in the G.O. read above without being subjected to medical Examination, even if one year has elapsed after the date of their retirement provided that the applicants have already indicated their intention to commute the maximum amount of their pension or expressed the amount proposed to be commuted as a fraction or percentage of the full and final pension, within the maximum permissible limit and are allowed to commute such fraction or percentage of pension sanctioned to them on the earlier occasion. The commutation amount will also be based on the same age next birth day as was adopted for the original commutation of pension.

## ORDER

Government are pleased to order that the orders on reservation of seats for admission to and monetary concessions in educational institutions on the basis of the Kumara Pillai Commission Report issued in the G. O. read as first paper above and the subsequent amendments thereto will continue to be in force during the academic year 1980-81 also, subject to the modifications indicated below:

- (1) The income ceiling of Rs. 6,000/- mentioned in para 2
- (a) of the G. O. MS. No. 185/77/H. Edn. dated 30-11-1977 will be enhanced to Rs. 8,000/-
- (2) The income ceiling of Rs. 8,000/- mentioned in para 2
- (b) of G. O. MS. No. 185/77/H. Edn. dated 30-11-1977 will be enhanced to Rs. 10,000/-
- 2. The annual family income limit for the grant of concession of full freeship to the students of Pre-Degree and Degree courses mentioned in para 3 (ii) of G. O. MS. 158/72/ Edn. dated 21-7-1972, as modified in G. O. MS. No. 107/76 H. Edn. dated 19-7-1976, will be enhanced as follows:-
- (i) The income limit of Rs. 18,00; for Pre-Degree will be enhanced to Rs.3,600/-
- (ii) The income limit of Rs.2,400/- for degree courses will be enhanced to Rs. 4,800/-.

# Item No. 1. Purchase of one Russian Compute EC 1033 to the University. Recommended that:

- 1) Prof. Gopalakrishnan Nair, Head, Dept. of Electronics, be asked to prepare a project report regarding the usefulness and functioning of the above type computer. He may visit Institutions where such a computer has been installed and hold discussions with the staff there.
- 2) The University may take immediate steps to purchase one Russian Computer EC 1033 utilising the facility offered

by the Government of India to import duty free computers to Universities.

- 3) The computer may be installed on the Ground Floor of the Ship Technology Building.
- Item No. 2. Shifting of Naval Architecture Classes held at Engineering College to Thrikkakara Campus.

#### Recommends that:

- 1) Immediate steps be taken to shift the classes to Ship Technology Department by October 1980.
- 2) The Department of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Management be requested to extend all possible assistance and Co-operation for the same.
- 3) Practical sessions in the concerned subjects be held for the time being in the departmental Laboratories of Physics and Chemistry Depts.
- 4) 5 vacant posts of lecturers in the Department of Ship Technology (1 post to be filled up and 4 posts of lecturers who are deputed for higher studies in GDR) be filled up immediately on a temporary basis from the students who have successfully completed B. Tech course in Ship Technology and Naval Architecture from our University. The vacancies may be notified on the Notice Board and selected candidates be appointed for a period of six months.
- 5) Immediate steps be taken to institute additional posts of 4 lecturers one each in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Business Management in the respective University departments to teach the above or allied subjects to the students

- of Ship Technology and Naval Architecture as well as the students of other departments as and when necessary.
- 6) All rooms becoming vacant hereafter in the Hostels at Thrikkakara Campus be reserved for the students of Ship Technology Course converting single rooms to double-bed rooms wherever possible.

# Item No. 3. Improvement in the functioning of the Health Centre,

#### Recommends that:

- 1) The hours of work of the Health Centre may be suitably fixed.
- 2) Steps be taken to appoint a full time Medical Officer if an experienced person is available preferably one who has retired from Government Service.

## Item No. 4. Own Your Own House Scheme

#### Recommends that:

- 1) The land purchased by the University for the above purpose be distributed to the employees.
- 2) The extent of land to be distributed to each applicant may be from 3 to 6 cents.
