Item No. 187.01: Confirmation of the minutes of the 186th meeting of the Syndicate held on 5-11-1983.

Resolved that the minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 5-11-1983 be confirmed subject to the following emendations:-

- 1. 186.03 (i) The words within brackets: ("Dr. P. N. Krishnan Nambisan dissented.") be added at the end of the decision.
- 2. 186.03 (iv) b) The dissent recorded be modified as follows: "Shri M. K. Raghavan dissented."
- 3. 186.03 xxx: The words "for the time being", be added to the sentence.
- 4. 186.09 (i) (b) The following words be added within brackets after the decision: ("Dr. P. N. Krishnan Nambisan dissented.")
- Item No. 187.02: Report of the Vice-Chancellor on important developments in the University since the last meeting.
- 1. The State Government has released a total grant of Rs. 65 lakhs for the construction of the Administrative Block. The original understanding was that the Government would give only Rs. 50 lakhs.

- 2. It is understood that the Ministry of Education, Government of India has approved a special assistance of Rs. 20 lakhs, for the proposed M. Tech programme in Computer & Information Sciences.
- 3. The Vice-Chancellor proposed that Mr. P. U. Cariappa General Manager, Cochin Shipyard be nominated as a member of the Board of Studies in Naval Architecture & Ship Building. The proposal was approved.
- 4. On the request of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, the University's Seventh Plan Proposals (1985-90) in respect of the Engineering & Technology Divisions have been sent to the Government of India so as to reach them on December 1, 1983. The proposals were prepared in consultation with the Heads of Departments and on the basis of the general guidelines given by the Ministry of Education. The proposals will be placed before the Planning Committee in due course along with the proposals under the General Sector:
- The Five-day Workshop on Environment and Development' sponsored by the University of Cochin (Department of Law) along with other agencies is well under way. The Fulbright Professor Dr. Armin Rosencranz and Dr. P. V. S. Namboodiripad of Perivar Chemicals are the co-ordinators of the Workshop.

- 5. The University of Cochin has participated in the Science & Technology exhibition organised at Valapad in connection with the Silver Jubilee Celebrations of Sree Rama Polytechnic there. Cochin University was represented by the Department of Marine Sciences and the Department of Ship Technology.
- 7. The Expert Committee appointed by the Government of Kerala to consider the proposal for setting up an Advanced Centre for Sciences & Technology visited the University on November 30, 1983. The Committee consisted of:
  - 1) Prof. V. R. Pillai, Member, State Planning Board
  - 2) Dr. V. R. Gowariker, Director, VSSC, Trivandrum.
    - 3) Shri M. R. Sitaraman, Joint Managing Director, KELTRON, Trivandrum.
    - 4) Dr. K. Gopalan, Vice-Chancellor, Cochin University
  - 5) Shri V. Ramachandran, Commissioner for Economic Development, Government of Kerala, Trivandrum.
    - 6) Dr. S. Vasudev, Chairman, State Committee on Science & Technology, Trivandrum.
    - Dr. Gowariker and Shri Sitaraman could not participate in the visit. They will be visiting the University separately.

- 8. As reported earlier, Cochin University has been chosen by the Government of India as one of the Nodal Centres of the National Manpower Information System.

  The University has already conveyed its acceptance to act as a Nodal Centre. The Nodal Centre will have an Advisory Committee consisting of the following:-
  - 1) The Head of the institution at each Nodal Centre (Chairman)
  - 2) The Director of Technical Education of the concerned State.
  - 3) The Director of Industries of the concerned State
  - 4) The Regional Officer of the Ministry of Education
  - 5). The Director of the Regional Apprenticeship Board
  - 6) Head of the State Manpower Unit/Department
  - 7) A representative from Institute of Applied Manpower
    Research
  - 8) Head of the Nodal Centre (Member Secretary)

We are proposing to convey to the Government of India that the Nodal Centre at Cochin University will be the School of Management Studies. The Head of the Nodal Centre will be the Director of the School of Management Studies.

The Staff approved for the Nodal Centre consists of: One Project Officer (Reader), One Personal Assistant and one research Associate. The Project Officer has to be a person with experience in (i) manpower planning and allied fields of research and (ii) in electronics data processing techniques. It is proposed to appoint Mrs. Annies Vincent of the School of Management Studies as the Project Officer (Reader), which is a purely temporary position sanctioned upto March 1985. She has more than 17 years of experience as Teaching Assistant/Lecturer in the School. She holds a First Class M. Sc. degree in Statistics and has adquate exposure to manpower planning and electronics data processing. She will undertake this new responsibility in addition to her teaching work in the School. The entire expenditure of the Nodal Centre which is purely a temporary arrangement till March 1985, will be met by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. The Syndicate approved the above proposal.

Item No. 187.03: Report of the Internal Evaluation Committee-consideration of.

The Syndicate considered the report of the Internal Evaluation Committee, along with the recommendations of the Standing Committee on Staff & Establishment.

Resolved that the report of the Internal Evaluation Committee in general be approved, and that the following specific recommendations be approved for implementation in consultation with the Statutory Finance Committee wherever necessary, without waiting for the confirmation of the Minutes.

- 1. The staff pattern of non-teaching staff proposed for the teaching departments of the University as in Appendix I be approved, subject to the modification that one post of Section Officer for each of the departments of Electronics and Industrial Fisheries be provided.
- 2. a). A new cadre of qualified technical staff (technicians) be created for the various laboratories and workshops of the University.

Details regarding the academic qualifications, experience, scales of pay etc. for the posts to be included in the cadre be worked out by a Committee constituted from among the heads of Science & Technology departments of the University.

- b) The proposal for granting grade promotions to an appropriate higher grade to Sweepers-cleaners, peons, technical staff in the lower categories, and others similarly placed, on completion of 10 years in a particular cadre be accepted in principle and the details worked out for implemention.
- c) Graduate typists with not less than 5 years service as typists in this University be given the option to join the cadre of Assistants, provided that they join as junior most in that cadre.

- d) The present practice of appointing sweepers/ cleaners and watchmen as Peons, and Peons as technical service personnel in the Library, Laboratory etc. be dispensed with.
- 3. The categorization of departmental libraries into A, B, & C be approved, along with the staff pattern proposed as in Appendix II. As regards category B, the library be manned initially by a Library Assistant Grade II until the collection grows sufficiently to justify the appointment of a Reference Assistant.
- Lakeside campus, along with the recommended staff pattern as in Appendix III be approved, subject to such marginal adjustments as might become necessary on actual implementation. The administrative control of the Library be with a professor in charge to be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor, whereas control over technical matters be vested in the University-Librarian.
- 5. (a) The functional division of work among the various sections of the University Library, along with the staff pattern as in Appendix IV be approved, subject to such marginal adjustments as might become necessary in the interest of the smooth operation of the system.
  - (b) The University Library may have the following staff in the lower categories:

- (1) Peons 3 (The remaining 5 peons be transferred with post to other departments/offices)
- (2) Library Attenders 3
- (3) Security staff 2

Library Attenders may be appointed from among peons who have studied upto SSLC on the basis of seniority and be given the sale of pay Rs. 300-450. They shall perform all the duties of peons and shall assist the professional staff in arranging books and periodicals and keeping them dust free.

- B. The organizational pattern of the Engineering Unit together with the staff structure as in *Appendix V* be approved.
- 7. The present administrative structure for the hostels may remain as it is subject to the administration of the hostel at Lakeside campus being brought under the control of the Hon. Warden, Trikkakara campus, who shall be designated Hon. Warden, University hostels.

An Asaistant Warden be appointed for the hostel

An administrative unit of the central office be establing shed at the Lakeside campus under a Section Office-which will handle such matters as fee collection of all departments located therein, maintenance of hostell and allied matters, security arrangements, upkeep

of buildings and gardens, preparation of establishment bills of common technical staff (crew of the vessels/ vehicles) library staff, security and maintenance personnel.

Note: Officers at A will report directly to the professorin-charge. Persons at B will report directly to the Section Officer.

The administrative control of the unit be vested in the Head of the Department/School on rotation for a period of one year to be appointed by the Vice Chancellor.

9. The crew of the vessels along with the research vessels / vehicles be separated from the teaching departments and placed under the control of the seniormost among the technical personnel (Deck Officer) for ensuring their operational efficiency. A head of the Department/School to be appointed by the Vice-Changellor on rotation be in charge of the unit.

10. The proposals regarding the line and span of control among the officers of the University along with the staff pattern as in *Appendices VI to IX* be generally approved, subject to regulation by the Vice-Chancellor in the exigencies of administration.
