Item No. 196.02: REPORT OF THE VICE-CHANCELLOR ON IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS IN THE UNIVERSITY SINCE THE LAST MEETING.

- 1. The School of Marine Sciences has been selected by the UGC for special assistance under the COSIST Programme. The purpose is to raise the infrastructural facilities for teaching and research to international standards. The University has submitted proposals for about 1.25 crores.
- 2. The Department of Electronics is organising a UGC-sponsored Summer Institute in Electronics for physics teachers teaching electronics at graduate and post-graduate levels, during September 12-October 12, 1984. The Summer Institute is expected to be formally inaugurated by Profibr. Ashoka Chandra, Educational Adviser (Technical) to the Government of India on September 12, 1984 at 4.00 p.m.

All the Syndicate members are cordially invited to be present at the inauguration.

- 3. The Indian Society for Technical Education (ISTE), New Delhi has cleared the conduct of a Summer Institute in Laser Technology by the Department of Physics.
- 4. The final clearance has come from West Germany (FRG) regarding the donation of an Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer (costing over Rs. 3 lakhs) by the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation to the School of Marine Sciences. Arrangements are being made to import the equipment.
- 5. Dr. M. Ramachandra Kaimal of the Department of Mathematics & Statistics has rejoined the Department after his one-year research work at the National Institute of Health, USA. He was working primarily on 'Computer simulation of body organs'.
- 6. Prof. (Dr.) C. S. Sridhar of the Department of Electronics has returned from Montreal, Canada after participating in the two-week international conference on 'Pattern Recognition'.
- 7. Prof. (Dr.) Christoph Reissmann of the Wilhelm-Pieck University Rostock is here on a three month visiting professorship in the Department of Ship Technology under the Indo-GDR Cultural Exchange Programme.
- 8. The Department of Ship Technology had a Fulbright Professor Dr. C. V. G. Vallabhan of Texas Tech University, USA fora 10 day-lecture series during August 21,-31, 1984.
- 9. This year's Public Law Lectures of the University were delivered by Prof. [Dr.] P. G. Krishnan of the Uniersity of Delhi during August 28-30, 1984. The theme was 'Social security in India: perspectives and prospects'.

- 10. The University had the following distinguished people to deliver lectures in the past couple of weeks:
- Prof. Dr. Sudheer P. Pandya, Director, Physical Research Laboratory, Ahemedabad gave a lecture on "Giant oscillations in Núclei".
- Prof. [Dr.] Hans Liebmann of the Harvard Law School USA gave a lecture on "Judicial activism and U. S. politics".
- Dr Harsh Gupta of the Centre for Earth Science Studies, Trivandum gave a lecture on "Third Indian Scientific expedition to Antarctica" of which he was the leader.
- Dr. R. Unnikrishnan of the Rochester Institute of Technology, New York gave a lecture on "Recent advances in power electronics".
- 11. A Film Club and a Chess club have been organised by the students of the University. The Film Club was formally inaugurated by the famous film actor and director Shri Balachandra Menon

As part of the Onam celebrations, the students also organised a cultural programme as well as a competition in floral decoration

- (ii) Sufficient number of application forms in distinct colour from those in use will be printed with the superscription "To be supplied free of cost to physically Handicapped candidates only". The Superintendent, Government Presses Trivandrum will take immediate action in this regard.
- (iii) The selling agents of embossed Public Service Commission application forms enumerated in Item (vii) of of G. O. MS 360/77/GAD dated 28.10.1977 as amended subsequently will also function as agents for the distribution of cost free forms to the physically handicapped candidates.
- (iv) The Public Service Commission shall issue necessary instructions to the distributing agents in the matter of distribution of cost free forms to the physically handicapped candidates.
- (v) The scheme for distribution of the cost free application forms to the physically handicapped candidates will be brought into operation from the date to be suggested by the Kerala Public Service Commission.
