Before taking up the business of the day the Syndicate paid homage to the late Shri M. N. Govindan Nair, Shri Y. B. Chavan and Dr. N. P. Pillai, the members standing up and observing a minute's silence.

The Syndicate then resolved to request the Government of Kerala to rename the University of Cochin as the "Indira Gandhi University of Science and Technology."

The Syndicate further resolved, in modification of its decision of November 9, 1984, to name the Trikkakara campus of the University as "Indira Gandhi Nagar."

Shri S C. S. Menon at this stage asked for a discussion on the disciplinary action taken by the Vice-Chancellor against Shri A. K. Gopinathan Nair, a driver of the University. The members noted that an appeal against any punishment imposed by the Vice-Chancellor directly lay with the Chancellor under Statute 47 (b) of the Cochin University First Statutes 1981. It was agreed that the driver, if aggrieved was free to appeal to the Chancellor.

Item No. 199.02 : Report of the Vice-Chancellor on important developments in the University since the last meeting.

1. The Vice-Chancellor had discussions with Prof. M. G. K. Menon of the Planning Commission, Dr. S. Z. Qasim

of the Department of Ocean Development and Prof. Rais Ahmed of the University Grants Commission, regarding University's Seventh Plan Proposals in general and the requirements of the School of Marine Sciences in particular. They have responded very positively.

2. Prof. G. Marmo and Prof. Morandi Guisepe of Italy visited the University during November 26-29, 1984 and gave lectures on 'Field theory' and 'Particle physics' in the Department of Physics.

3. Colonel SAF Fernandez of the Armed Forces visited the University on November 30, 1984 and gave a lecture on 'Career opportunities in the Armed Forces'.

4. Prof. (Dr.) C. Purushothaman of the Department of Physics has been given the Sahitya Academy Award of Rs. 1,000/- for his work "Surya Kudumbam" in the category of Science and Linguistics Studies.

5. The Academic Council met on November 27, 1984 and took decisions on various academic issues.

6. Swami Purushothamananda—disciple of Swami Chinmayananda—is giving a lecture on 'Bhagavad Gita' in the SMS Auditorium on December 4, 1984 at 4-00 p. m.

7. Prof. (Dr.) C. S. Sridhar of the Department of Electronics has been deputed to participate in the International Conference on "Computer Systems and Signal Processing" to be held at Bangalore during December 10-12, 1984.

The Committee noted that there are Departments/Schools where there are regular vacancies of UJRF as noted against each, have no applicants. ORDER

As per Article 245 (c) iii of the Kerala Financial Code, the amount of Cycle Advance payable to an officer is 3 months pay or Rs. 300 or the anticipated price of the vehicle whichever is least.
