Before the items on the Agenda were taken up for consideration, the Vice-Chancellor draw the attention of the Members, the sudden demise of Shri. Item No. 251.02 **Report of the Vice-Chancellor on important development in the University since the last meeting.**

1. Dr. S. Z. Quasim, Secretary, Department of Ocean Development, Government of India addressed the meeting conveneotor celebrating the Golden Jubilee Celebrations of the School of Marine Sciences on 22nd December 1988. On December 23, 1988 Dr. Quasim also evaluated the progeess of the programmes initiated under COSIST assistance of the UGC as a member of the evaluation team appointed by the UGC.

2. Prof. Satish Dhawan, Member, Space Commission and a distinguished Scientist delivered the Raman Memorial lecture on December 27, 1988 at the lecture hall of the Department of Electronics of the University. This lecture on 'Aerodynamics of bird flight' sponsored by the National Institute of Oceanography, Cochin Centre was attended by several scientists of the R & D Organisations at Cochin and around and also by members of the staff and students of the University.

3. A Study Team of the School of Management Studies of the University visited Lakadives on the request of the Administration of the Island to study the Administrative structure of the Island administration and submitted a report suggesting various worthwhile changes in the existing administrative structure.

4. The Indian Science Congress Association has finally decided to hold the next Science Congress at the University campus during January 1990. The delegation consisting of 16 teachers with Prof. P. Ramachandra poduval as the Co-ordinator visited Madurai from 8-10 January 1989 to study the various aspect of holding the Science Congress. The Vice-Chancellor, Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Registrar University Engineer and the Public Relations Officer also visited Madurai for the purpose.

5. Sir Anthony Laughten from U.K. a world famous authority on Marine Sciences who has been invited to India by the Government of India to visit some of the Universities and R & D Organization will be visiting the University and the School of Marine Sciences on January 23, 1989. He will be addressing the members of the Faculty, students and invitees from the R & D Organisation at a meeting to be held for the purpose at 3.30 p.m. on 23.1.1989 at the auditorium of the Industrial Fisheries Department of the University.

6. The expert UGC Visiting Committee scheduled to visit the University from 18-20 January 1989 for evaluating the VII Plan performance of the University postponed their visit to early March 1989 due to some unavoidable in-convenience to some members of the Visiting Team.

7. The meeting suggested that the Prime Minister of India who is visiting Kerala in April-May 1989 may be invited to inaugurate The DRDO-Cohin University Computer Centre nearing completion.
