Item No.375.01 : Confirmation of the minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 05-12-1996 (374th).

1) In item No.374.01 - Confirmation of the minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 23-11-1996 (373th), in the emendation suggested under para 3, the paragraph given in quotation be replaced as follows:

"The syllabus of all technical courses in CUSAT be updated every three years. Suggestions from the local industries may be considered in doing so".

2) In the emendation suggested under Sl. No.6 (to item 373.16) the second paragraph starting with "While" be replaced with the following:

"While confirming the last item the Vice-Chancellor said that the question of promoting Smt.Kunjoonjamma as Jeint Registrar cannot be considered now in the light of the available legal advice".

- 3) Item No.374.24, last line of the first paragraph of the resolution be corrected as "joint guidance of Dr.P. Madhavan Pillai and Dr.Jacob Philip".
- 4) In the minutes of the 374th meeting of the Syndicate held on 05-12-1996, the resolution under item 374.26 be modified as follows:

"The post of Selection Grade Assistant held by Shri.P.A.Tagmas in the CALLA Section, University Office be transferred to the Hostel Office and redesignated as Hostel Manager in the level and scale of pay of a Section Officer in the University, and Shri.P.A. Thomas be appointed as Hostel Manager. Sri.M.E. Sankaran working as Assistant Grade II in the Hostel Office be transferred to GALLA Section along with the post. This will not affect the ratio promotion of Assistants in the University."

5. Arising out of the discussion while confirming the minutes under item No.374.27, the Syndicate urged the necessity of regularising all the posts in the Centre for Undergraduate Studies in Engineering, and resolved that a meeting of the Managing Committee of CUGSE be called in the first week of January 1997 to discuss this matter.

Arising out of the confirmation of minutes, Dr.K.G. Nair called for the attention of the House on non-implementation of a Syndicate decision 370.03 "In the absence of any regular teacher in the service of the University, one of the lecturers having qualification in Mechanical Engineering appointed on ad hoc basis for the under graduate engineering degree programme under the self financing scheme be regularised and deputed to DELFT University, Netherlands". The Registrar explained the difficulties in implementing the decision which was agreed by the Syndicate. Syndicate resolved to send Sri.G. Ajithkumar, ad hoc lecturer in Mechanical Engineering, Centre for Under Graduate Studies in Engineering, without any obligations on the part of University to provide any employment on completion of the training.

Item No.375.02 : Report of Vice-Chancellor on important developments in the University since last meeting.

- (i) The 41st Congress of Indian Society of Theoratical and Applied Mechanics organised under the auspices of the Department of Mathematics of the University was held during 17-19 December 1996.
- (ii) Dr.Rastagi from Netherlands visited the University during 18-20 December 1996 and had discussions with the officials of the Centre for MHO Co-operation on various aspects of the implementation of the project.
