Special Item reported by the Vice-Chancellor:

The Vice-Chancellor informed the members that the outcome of the visit of the UGC XI Plan Committee to the University during 13-16 July 2008 was very positive. He stated that the Committee was extremely pleased with the performance of the University and also conveyed the Committee's appreciation to Prof. V.P.N. Nampoori and his team for excellent manner in which the entire programme was conducted. He also expressed the confidence that the amount recommended by the Committee for this University for the XI plan would be far higher than that compared to previous years.

In response, Sri. Baby Chakrapani stated that capitalizing on the above situation, the University should also initiate steps to submit proposal to UGC to obtain the status of 'University with Potential for Excellence (UPE)' so that higher funding assistance could be obtained. The Vice-Chancellor agreed to this suggestion and also suggested that a team could be formed to pilot this proposal.

Dr. Joy Job Kulavelil, while appreciating the positive outcome of the UGC Committee visit stated that he did also have reservations in the manner in which the said event was conducted. He stated that the Syndicate being the Chief Executive body of the University should have been taken into confidence and its suggestions also considered regarding the modalities of conducting such important events involving external committees.

Items brought forward by the Vice-Chancellor:

The Vice-Chancellor brought to the attention of the Syndicate the request received from the Toc H Institute of Science & Technology, Arakkunnam vide their letters No.TIST/P/5426/2008-09 dated 7.7.08 and TIST/MBA/8612/2008-09 dated 9.7.08 to permit them to admit 50% students from the entrance test conducted by CUSAT and the balance 50% from MAT eligible candidates for their new MBA course.

The Syndicate considered the request and resolved the following:-

- Pending a detailed study of the implications of this request including effecting necessary amendments to the concerned Regulations in this regard, the Toc H Institute of Science & Technology, Arakkunnam may be permitted to admit 60% students from the entrance test conducted by CUSAT and the balance 40% from MAT eligible candidates for their new MBA course for the academic year 2008-09 only.
- (ii) To immediately review the admission criteria being followed by the CONSPI Academy for their MBA course and to direct them to also follow the criteria stipulated at (i) above, if their existing criteria is found to be different.
- (iii) To initiate steps to evolve a uniform admission criteria in this regard as a matter of policy. To make a separate regulation for all programmes except B.Tech. and to enforce it from next Academic year/admission.

Item No.532.01 Confirmation of the minutes of the 531st meeting of the Syndicate held on 28.06.2008.

The Syndicate considered the draft minutes of 531th meeting of the Syndicate held on 28.06.2008 and approved the same with the following emendations:-

 In first paragraph of item no.1 under 'Special Items reported by the Vice-Chancellor replace the word 'written' with 'writing'. 2. Special Items no.1 be modified as follows:-

"Before taking items of the agenda, the issue of Rear Admiral B.R. Menon and the action taken by the State Government on it was raised.

After detailed deliberations the Syndicate unanimously resolved to remove Rear Admiral B.R. Menon from the Advisorship of Marine Engineering programme. Also resolved to request the Government to make an enquiry on his role in the University during his tenure."

- 3. In Item No.531.05 delete the last three paragraphs of the resolution.
- 4. In Item No.531.08 replace the word 'report' instead of 'findings' appearing in the second paragraph of the minutes.
- 5. In Item No.531.11, no.(i) of the resolution be modified as follows:

"To expedite the issue, the service of an expert (retired Revenue Officer) may be sought, in consultation with the Convener, Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Works."

- 6. In Item No.531.39 modify item no.(ii) of the resolution under 'Qualifications' as under:-
 - "(ii) Ten years experience in Research/Teaching/Management/Administration/ Strategic Planning in Science Administration/Higher Education/ Industry."

Replace the word 'Direct' instead of 'External' under the heading '3. Mode of recruitment'.

Item No.532.03 Persons with disabilities (equal opportunities, protection of rights and full participation) Act 1995 — Identification of the posts suitable for recruitment — Consideration of.

The Syndicate considered the recommendations of the Standing Committees of the Syndicate on Finance & Purchase and Staff & Establishment on the matter of identification of the posts suitable for recruitment reserved for persons with disabilities.

Resolved that 3 post in Class III Category and 2 posts in Class IV Category of the University be earmarked for persons with disabilities under the Scheme of Direct Recruitment of Physically Handicapped in Cochin University Service, implemented vide U O No.Ad.A2/215/98 (PH) dated 05.11.1999.

The posts be distributed as follows:

The Syndicate ratified the action of the Vice-Chancellor i.e., the service of the Warden-cum-Physical trainer and Mess-Manager-cum-Assistant Warden at Kunjali Marakkar School of Marine Engineering was outsourced from the list forwarded by the Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer, Ernakulam for a period of one year at a consolidated remuneration of Rs.10000/- p.m. and Rs.8000/- p.m. respectively.

The Syndicate considered the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Academic Matters on the following Regulations/Amendment to Regulations and approved the same.

(1) The decision of the Academic Council to follow the rules for lateral entry courses offered in SOE to B. Tech PS & RT and Instrumentation course be made applicable from 2004 onwards (Item No. I b(7) of Academic Council minutes.)

Recommended to approve, the decision of the Academic Council to calculate CGPA, classification and finalisation of the results in respect of B. Tech Instrumentation students through lateral entry based on six semesters attended by the students. (Item II (27) of the Academic Council minutes).

(2) The formula for calculation of approximate percentage from CGPA for courses under credit system as approved by the Academic Council be made effective from 2004 pass out batch (vide Academic Council meeting held on 26.3.08) and from 2007 Admission (vide Academic Council meeting held on 4.8.07).

- (iii) As the scheme is proposed for implementation from the 2008 admissions onwards, this needs to be accorded top-priority.

Item No.532.12 Dr. Mary Lourde R., Reader, Department of Electronics –

Unauthorized absence – Request to rejoin duty – Reg.

The Syndicate considered the request dated 17.08.2007 for extension of leave for 3 more years from 06.08.2006 and the subsequent requests dated 18.11.2007 and 02.04.2008 expressing her willingness to rejoin duty in June/July 2008.

The Syndicate resolved the following:-

- (i) Request for extension of leave be declined, and Dr. Mary Lourde R. may be directed to report for duty immediately, failing which appropriate disciplinary action may be initiated.
- (ii) To send communications to all employees who have been granted L.W.A., informing them that no further leave extension will be granted to them as a matter of principle and that in cases where leave extensions are proposed to be sought on genuine grounds, requests for the same should be received by the University at least 6 months prior to the expiry of the leave period.

(iii) Further, wherever such reports are received by the University, the same should be acted upon immediately by the concerned Administration Section and an appropriate response sent to the applicant without delay, so as to not give any scope to the applicant to presume that his/her request for leave extension stands approved by the University, in the absence of any communication from the University to the contrary.

Item No.532.13 Time Bound Higher Grade granted to employees not in conformity with that in Government – Granting of HRA/CCA at higher rates to the non-teaching staff of CUSAT – Resolution of the Syndicate – Reg.

The Syndicate considered the recommendations of the Standing Committees of the Syndicate on Finance & Purchase and Staff & Establishment regarding release of withheld amount of DCRG of all the employees who retired from the University Service and granting of HRA/CCA to all the non-teaching employees working in the Thrikkakara Campus at City rates.

The Higher Grade granted to the employees upto 27.12.2003 was according to the decision of the Syndicate. The Syndicate observed that the Hon'ble High Court, in two different cases, reiterated that, the Syndicate has every right to grant such benefits to it's employees.

Hence the Syndicate resolved to release the withheld amount of DCRG of all the employees who have retired from the University Service.

Also resolved that the issue of payment of HRA/CCA to all the non-teaching employees working in the Thrikkakara Campus at City rates, be placed before the committee constituted by the Syndicate to examine the objections raised by the Local Fund Accounts Committee (9 member Assembly Committee).

Nos. 2, 3, 9, 10, 17, 18, 25, 27, 28, 32, 35, 36 and 42 in Annexure – III) to that of Readers in the scale of pay of Rs.12000-420-18300 with effect from the dates recommended by the Selection Committee as given in Annexure – III for placing the teachers as Readers under Career Advancement Scheme of AICTE.

Also resolved that if any questions regarding seniority among teachers arise due to this decision, this is to be got reviewed by the Syndicate separately.

Further resolved that anomalies on account of implementation of the UGC Career Advancement Schemes, relating to teachers in Departments other than the School of Engineering/CUCEK, which are still pending, may be got immediately reviewed and placed before the Syndicate urgently.

Ship in Campus Lab of the Kunjali Marakkar School of Marine Engineering - Work of supply, erection, commissioning and testing of machinery & equipments awarded to M/s. Hoosami Metal Industries (P) Ltd. — Request for allowing of Security Deposit as Bank Guarantee instead of cash deposit — Consideration of — reg.

The Syndicate considered the request of M/s. Hoosami Metal Industries (P) Ltd., Bhavnagar, Gujarat to allow them to pay the security deposit to the University as bank guarantee instead of cash deposit.

The Syndicate already approved to grant 75% payment to M/s. Hoosami Metal Industries (P) Ltd. against cost of materials already supplied by them vide Item No.531.27 on 28.06.2008.

On their request to allow them to pay the security deposit to the University as bank guarantee instead of cash deposit the Syndicate resolved that M/s. Hoosami Metal Industries (P) Ltd. may be allowed to furnish a Bank Guarantee of a Nationalized Bank towards remittance of the Security Deposit due for this work. The validity of the Bank Guarantee shall be upto 31.07.2009, so as to cover the successful erection, trials, commissioning and certification of the system of 'Ship-in-Campus' by IIT Kharagpur or by a competent Marine Surveyor and the warranty period thereafter. It shall also be the responsibility of the Director, Kunjali Marakkar School of Marine Engineering to ensure timely extension of the validity period of the Bank Guarantee, if so called for, in order to realize the objectives of obtaining the Security Deposit and protecting the interest of the University.

The Syndicate considered the request for providing 'Examination Contingency Fund' in the name of Controller of Examinations with a separate head of account to meet the unforeseen expenditure incurred in connection with the conduct of urgent examination confidential works.

The Syndicate resolved to provide Rs.1.00 Lakh as 'Examination Contingency Fund' in the name of Controller of Examinations.

Items considered outside the Agenda:

(1) As an outcome on discussions relating to Item no. 532.02 [Comprehensive Report on the functioning of the Internal Audit & Inspection (IA & I) section], concern was expressed by Dr. Joy Job Kulavelil and Sri. N.K. Vasudevan regarding the unduly high workload of the Finance Officer in-charge Registrar resulting in a situation where important issues relating to the Finance Wing also, like the item in question are not getting the due attention it deserves. It was stated that the arrangement of the Finance Officer being given the responsibility of the additional charge of Registrar may not be viable and effective as both these posts carry heavy workloads & responsibilities. This was supported by Adv. K. Mohanachandran, Sri. Baby Chakrapani, Dr. S. Salim and Sri. C.M. Dinesh Mani, MLA. However, Dr. K.N. Chandrasekharan Pillai, Prof. P.O.J. Lebba, Dr. V.P.N. Nampoori and Dr. I.S. Bright Singh expressed the view that there was no

immediate reason to disturb the existing arrangement and that a better approach would have been to delegate some of the existing powers of the Registrar and Finance Officer to their respective subordinate officers.

After detailed discussions and deliberations, it was finally resolved that the Vice Chancellor be authorized to immediately nominate an appropriate person from among the Teaching faculty to be given the charge of Registrar.

Dr. K.N. Chandrasekharan Pillai expressed his dissent on the above resolution and the dissent note submitted by Dr.K.N.Chandrasekharan Pillai is marked as Annexure – IV.

(2) Fixing and Convening of Standing Committee meetings:

- (i) The date of convening the various meetings of the standing Committees of the Syndicate may be fixed in consultation with the Conveners of the concerned Committees.
- (ii) The present practice of convening the meetings of the Standing Committees of the Syndicate on a single day may be discontinued and the same be spread over two days.
- (3) The status of the Report on the incident of fire that occurred in the International School of Photonics may be placed in the next Syndicate meeting.
- (4) The University Order no. Ac.A2/11660/06 dated 5.7.08 issued regarding the representation proposed to be given to students of the Recognized Institutions of CUSAT in the General Council of Cochin University Union may be got reviewed.
- (5) The representation submitted by the Security Guards regarding insufficiency of the existing 'Uniform Allowance' was examined by the Syndicate and resolved to purchase and distribute Uniform for the Security Guards.
