 The Vice Chancellor informed the Syndicate that Sri Praveen has been elected as the Chairman of the University Students Union and thereby he has become a member of the Syndicate.

The Syndicate welcomed the new member, Sri Praveen, the Chairman, University Union to the Syndicate.

 The Vice Chancellor informed the Syndicate that the Chancellor have agreed to have the special convocation on December 4, 2010 to award the Honarary Doctorate to Justice K.G. Balakrishnan, Sri E Sreedhar and Sri Kalamandalam Ramankutty and steps have been initiated to conduct the same on December 4, 2010

- 3. The Vice Chancellor informed the Syndicate that the Government of Kerala has constituted a Governing Council for the IUC IPR with the Minister for Education as Chairman and the CUSAT Vice Chancellor as the Vice chairman and the first meeting was held on 27-10-2010 at Thiruvananthapuram.
- 4. The Vice Chancellor reported to the Syndicate that CUSAT has signed an MOU with the UGC- INFLIBNET for the programme Shod Ganga, digitalizing the Ph.D. Dissertations and networking on 28-10-2010.
- 5. The Vice Chancellor informed the Syndicate that AICTE has conducted a surprise inspection at CUCEK on 28-10-2010.
- The Vice Chancellor reported to the Syndicate that the family of Sri Joseph Mundassery has expressed their desire to institute an endowment in the name of Sri Joseph Mundassery in CUSAT.
- 7. The Vice Chancellor reported to the Syndicate that Justice V.R.Krishna Iyer Chair has been established in CUSAT.
- 8. The Vice Chancellor reported to the Syndicate that International Seminar in Climate Change was conducted jointly with NISCAIR, Delhi during October 24 26, 2010.
- 9. The Vice Chancellor reported to the Syndicate that CUSAT has started this year's ERUDITE programme at the ISP.
- The Vice Chancellor had a visit at M.G.University in connection with the Nober Laurate programme.
- 11. The Vice Chancellor informed the Syndicate that University Union took the oath on September 13, 2010 and the Union was inaugurated on October 19, 2010.
- 12. The Vice Chancellor informed the Syndicate that CUSAT has entered into an MOU with Kerala Agriculture University for the conduct of a M.Sc. Course in Climate Changing.

- 3. The Syndicate resolved to fix the date of effect of Examination Manual from 01-01-2011
- 4. The syndicate resolved to form a committee of all the Deans and Pro-Vice-Chancellor as the Convener to prepare the norms for selection criteria for future appointments of teachers.

Further resolved that all the norms adopted by respective selection committees in the past stands approved.
