Item No. 126.01. Confirmation of the minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on August 4, 1979.

Resolved that the Minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 4-8-1979 be confirmed subject to the following emendations.

Item No. 125.08. (a) The following be added to complete the sentence under (i) "and that the panel be valid for one year w.e.f. 1-9-1979"

(b) (ii) be emended to read: "that the assignment of duty from the panel be on the basis of seniority in service"

(c) (iv) the word 'turn' be deleted after 'duty'

Item No. 126.02. Report of the Vice Chancellor on important developments in the University since the last meeting including items directly presented by him.

(a) The Central Instrumentation and Services Laboratory of the University was inaugurated by Prof. B. Ramachandra Rao, Vice Chairman, UGC, on August 30, 1979.

(b) He had a meeting with the Ministers of Education, Finance and Transport at Trivandrum on August 28 at which the University's request for an advance of Rs. 10/- lakhs for the construction of the Administrative Block was discussed. The University is assured of the assistance asked for. The Minister of Transport is expected to visit the Hill Palace on September 14th to discuss the question of transfer of vacant space for utilization by the Department of Archaeology.

(c) Dr. Ansehl of GDR Embassy had visited Cochin for examining the arrangements already made for the stay of the Professors from his country soon expected to join the Faculty of the Department of Naval Architecture and Ship Technology and was satisfied with the accommodation offered them at the Guest House of the Kerala Press and Publications Limited at Trikkakara.

He had, however, requested that the Professors be given certain additional facilities in order to make their stay more comfortable.

The Syndicate considered the nature of the additional facilities asked for and resolved that the matter be referred to the UGC for guidance.

(d) The Special Officer, School of Continuing Education has sought the specific sanction of the Syndicate for urgently purchasing 3 tonnes of printing paper from the open market in view of the scarcity of that commodity and its daily soaring price.

Resolved that the Special Officer, School of Continuing Education be permitted to purchase 3 tonnes of printing paper from the open market and that the minimum requirements of the University Office be also met from the quantity thus purchased.

(e) The Special Officer, School of Continuing Education has asked for sanction for admitting late applicants to courses offered by the School on realization of late fee at the rate of Rs. 10/-

Resolved that the Special Officer be authorised to entertain late applications to courses under the School on realization of late fee at the rate of Rs. 10/-

(f) The Head of the Department of Physics has sought an increase in the sanctioned strength of students for M.Sc. in Physics from 20 to 25 with effect from the current academic year.

Resolved that the sanctioned strength of students admitted to M.Sc. in Physics be increased from 20 to 25 w. e. f. the current academic year.

(g) There is no uniformity in the rates of application fee and registration fee charged by the various departments/schools of the University.

Resolved that :

i) An application fee of Rs. 10/- and a registration fee of Rs. 10/- be levied for all courses offered by the University; and

ii) These be effective from 1980 admissions.

h) As the University would close for Onam Holidays on the afternoon of September 1, and as the stretch of holidays ending on Sunday, September 9, was intervened by only one working day viz. Friday, September 7, that day also may be declared an holiday for the University Office and departmental offices, for the same be compensated by work on October 13, a second Saturday.

Resolved that Friday September 7, be a holiday for the University Office and Departmental Offices and that in its stead Saturday October 13, be a working day for the University and departmental offices.

The Syndicate considered the application of Shri. P. Mohan, full-time Research Fellow, under the CSIR sponsored scheme "Design and Development of the High Gain Microwave Horn Antennas" in the Department of Physics for registration for research leading to the award of the Ph.D. Degree of the University along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Academic Matters.
