At the outset the Hon. Vice Chancellor welcomed the members and proceeded to discuss the items.

1. Department of Applied Chemistry -- The proposal to add the following two courses to the list of elective course in the M.Sc. Chemistry programme

- i) CHE 21-352-10910 Transition Metals: Chemistry and Applications in Organic Synthesis (4 credit) for Integrated M.Sc. Semester IX, which is already approved for II Semester of M.Sc. Chemistry.
- ii) CHE 21-341-2315 New Methods and Strategies in Organic Synthesis and Dynamic Stereochemistry (4 credit) for M.Sc. Semester III.
- iii) CHE 21-352-10911 New Methods and Strategies in Organic Synthesis and Dynamic Stereochemistry (4 credit) for Integrated M.Sc. Semester IX.

The committee considered the proposal and recommended to approve the syllabus of the above courses and to add them to the list of electives in the M.Sc. Chemistry programme

2. Department of Biotechnology -- Approval of NPTEL Course as elective

The committee considered the request for approval of the NPTEL Course Drug Delivery: Principles and Engineering offered by IISC Bangalore, which has been opted for and successfully completed by Mr. Vishnu Soman S., IV Semester M.Sc. Biotechnology student. The committee recommended to approve the NPTEL Course.

3. International School of Photonics -- Approval for NPTEL courses and list of students opted for NPTEL courses.

The department had submitted for the consideration of the committee, the NPTEL course 'Research Methodology in Natural Sciences, (IISER Kolkata) with 3 credits, to be offered for the VIII Semester students of M.Sc. (5 year Integrated) in Photonics programme. The same course has been offered to some students of X Semester as supplementary and special supplementary MOOC course to fulfil the requirements of credits for VIII and IX semesters. It was decided to recommend the NPTEL course Research Methodology in Natural Sciences (IISER Kolkata), for approval.

The committee also recommended to approve the list of 24 students of VIII Semester M.Sc. (5 year Integrated) in Photonics programme who have opted for the above course offered by NPTEL as part of MOOC Programme and also the list of students of X Semester who were offered the same course as supplementary and special supplementary MOOC course to fulfil the requirements of credits for VIII and IX semesters.

4. DDUKK -- Approval of List of MOOC courses opted by M.Voc. students

The committee considered the list of students and MOOC courses opted by them for the second semester (2023 admission) of M.Voc. in Software Application Development and M.Voc. in Consultancy Management programmes. The committee recommended to approve the list of students and MOOC courses opted by them.

5. ICREP – Approval of syllabus of Interdisciplinary electives

The committee considered the syllabus of the following interdisciplinary electives to be offered at ICREP from the academic year 2024-25 onwards:

1. 22-851-0311 Environmental Ethics, Law and Scientific Research (3 credits) Online mode
2. 22-851-0312 Principles relating to Biosafety and Bioethics in Bioscience Research (3 credits) Offline mode

The committee recommended to approve the syllabus of the above electives and their course code.

6. IUCIPRS – Approval of Syllabus of Interdisciplinary elective and course code

The committee considered the syllabus of the Interdisciplinary elective Course Patent Drafting (3 credit) with course codes 22-403-0312 and 22-403-0412 and recommended to approve the same. The course codes of following courses were also recommended for approval.

1. IP and Management as 22-403-0311 and 22-403-0411
2. Patenting Inventions : Practice and Introduction to Relevant Tools as 22-403-0313 and 22-403-0413

7. SMS – Approval for MOOC courses opted by MBA (FT) III Semester and MBA (PT) V Semester students.

The committee considered the list of students and MOOC courses opted by

1. MBA(FT) students from SWAYAM/NPTEL platforms with course code 21-371-0403, during the III Semester and it's marks to be reflected in the IV Semester marklist.
