Item No. 212.02 : Report of the Vice-Chancellor on important developments in the University since the last meeting

1. Formal orders of the Government of India have been received for the establishment of the DRDO University of Cochin Computer Centre. We hope to start the work on the Computer Centre very soon.

2. The 51st Conference of the Indian Mathematical Society which was hosted by the University was a great success. A large number of faculty members, students and staff under the leadership of Dr. Trivikraman worked very hard with commitment and devotion to make the Conference successful.

The Syndicate placed on record its appreciation of the efforts put in by the faculty, students and staff for the successful conduct of the 51st Conference of the Indian Mathematical Society.

3. Prof. P. N. Krishnan Nambisan of the School of Marine Sciences has been nominated to the editorial board of Indian Journal of Marine Sciences published by the Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR) for a period of three years effective from 1-1-1986.

4. The Marine Products Export Development Authority is understood to have sanctioned a grant of Rs. 10,000/- for the National Seminar on Mussel watch scheduled to be conducted by the University during February 13-14, 1986.

5. The Director of the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Dr. P. K. Iyengar visited the Department of Physics this morning.

6. The Central Institute of Fisheries, Nautical and Engineering Technology, have requested us to co-sponsor the International Seminar on "Education and training for marine fisheries management and development," which they are organising. I suggested that we co-sponsor the seminar by making a token contribution of Rs. 5,000/-

- a) Degree/Diploma in Electronics, Electrical Engineering or Computer Operations from a recognised University/Institution.
- b) Experience in operating Mini Computer will be desirable.
- c) Age : Not more than 25 years.

APPENDIX TO ITEM No. 212.24

Rules for the Allotment and Occupation of Rooms in the Hostel for Non-Teaching Staff of the University

1. Short Title and Commencement

(a) These rules shall be called the Rules for the Allotment and Occupation of rooms in the Hostel for the Non-teaching staff (Men) of the University of Cochin.

(b) These rules shall have immediate effect.

2. Definitions :

In these rules, unless the context suggests otherwise:

- i) 'Applicant' means any male University Employee belonging to the category the non-teaching staff of the University;
- ii) 'Allottee' means an employee who has been allotted a seat in one of the rooms in the Hostel, as per these rules.
- iii) 'Employee' means a male person in the regular and full-time non-teaching service of the University.
- iv) 'Hostel' means the Hostel for Non-teaching employees of the University.
- v) 'Occupant' means an allottee who has occupied the seat allotted to him on completion of the prescribed formality and agreed to abide by the conditions of allotment.
- vi) Rent means the monthly rent payable by an occupant as specified in these rules.
- vii) Pay means pay as defined in Rule 12 (23) Part I K. S. R.

3. Eligibility :

i) Only a full-time regular male non-teaching employee coming under the category of the non-teaching staff of the University intending to stay in a room together with other allottees in the Hostel is eligible to apply for and be entitled to allotment of accommodation in the Hostel.

ii) An officer who owns a residential building within the city of Cochin or within a radius of 15 kms. from the place of work either in one's own name or in the name of his wife or, in the name of any minor son or daughter, whether, inherited or purchased or acquired otherwise including under any higher purchase scheme, shall not be eligible for accommodation in the University Hostel.

Note: i) An officer who secures accommodation and avails himself of it by suppressing the above information shall be treated as being on unauthorised occupation of the University hostel. Such an occupant shall be liable to eviction proceedings according to the provisions of the Kerala Public Buildings (Eviction of unauthorised occupation) Act 1963, in addition to disciplinary action. The occupant shall also be liable to pay rent at the penal rates at three times the standard rent for the period of unauthorised occupation.

ii) If an occupant were to acquire a residential building in the manner referred to in Rule 4 (ii) above, the fact shall be intimated immediately to the Registrar and the occupant shall vacate the

Hostel within one month of the date of such acquisition, failing which he shall be liable to be proceeded against in the manner indicated in Note 1, to Rule 4 (ii).

- iii) An employee who has availed himself of any House Building Loan from the University shall not be entitled to allotment of accommodation in the Hostel.
- iv) An officer who is or whose wife is already in occupation of University quarters shall not be eligible for accommodation in the Hostel.

4. Notification Inviting Applications :

- i) The Registrar shall initially invite applications for allotment of accommodation in the Hostel for preparation of priority lists for each of the categories listed in para 5 and when vacancies arise in future.
- ii) The notification shall be in the form of a circular to all Departments/Schools/Offices of the University allowing the employees 15 clear days' notice from the date of notification to submit applications in the prescribed form (Copy appended).
- iii) The applications thus received shall be scrutinised for their eligibility as per rules. Defective applications will be rejected. Valid applications shall be entered in a register maintained for the purpose.

5. Preparation of priority list and criteria for determining priority :

- (i) Quota shall be fixed for different categories of employees as detailed below:-

- (ii) Separate priority lists of employees belonging to the above categories shall be prepared on the basis of their total continuous service in a particular cadre under the University of Cochin.
- (iii) Age will be the criterion of allotment if two or more applicants have the same period of service, the older applicant getting the priority.

6. Special Priority :

Ten percent of the quota fixed for each category will be available for special allotment to: (1) physically handicapped (2) members of the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe communities.

If sufficient number of applications from eligible employees are not received from any of the categories

mentioned above, the resultant vacancies shall be allotted to other categories of employees as decided by the Vice-Chancellor from time to time.

7. Validity of priority lists :

The priority lists prepared as per rules 5 and 6 for different categories of employees shall be valid for the initial allotment.

8. Allotment of Rooms :

i) Allotment of rooms shall strictly be in accordance with the separate priority list maintained for each category of employees.

ii) Where sufficient number of applicants are not available in the priority list for any particular category of employees, the available surplus may be allotted to the applicants from other categories who are on the wait list, according to the discretion of Vice-Chancellor.

iii) The Vice-Chancellor shall, however, have the right to allot rooms to any employee out of turn for any special reasons to be recorded.

9. Conditions of allotment and occupation :

i) The allottee shall occupy the rooms allotted within 7 days of the date of advice from the Registrar, unless extension of time is granted by the Vice-Chancellor for genuine reasons, but liability for rent will commence from the 7th day of advice or the day of occupation, whichever is earlier.

ii) If the allottee is not in need of the room allotted to him, the fact should be reported to the Registrar in writing within 7 days of the date of advice. The allottee's name shall thereupon be struck off from the Register and from the priority list. The Vice-Chancellor may, however, permit retention of the allottee's name in the priority list for consideration for any casual vacancy during the pendency of the priority list, if he is satisfied that the allottee has not been able to occupy the seat for reasons beyond his control.

iii) The allotment given to an employee shall not on any account be sub-let.

iv) Rent for the room shall be recovered by deduction from the pay bill of the employee every month by the respective disbursing officers or by the employee himself who draws his salary bill. If the rent is omitted to be recovered from his pay, the occupant shall ensure that it is remitted at the University Office without delay.

v) A caution deposit of Rs 25/- shall be deposited by each allottee with the University.

vi) The inmates of each room shall be responsible for any damage caused to the electrical installations, cots etc. therein and the inmates of the hostel shall be collectively responsible for any damage done to the building or electrical installations, water connections, wash basins etc. or any of the common facilities provided.

vii) Inmates shall not cook food inside the rooms.

viii) Inmates shall not entertain guests within the hostel without the permission of the University. Hostel shall not be used as a place for gambling, consuming alcoholic drinks, or for holding meetings, or other activities, either undesirable or prejudicial to the interests of the University.

Details of rent payable, electricity & water charges etc. will be prescribed separately.
