Item No. 75.02 Minute by the Chancellor

(Considered by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 22-2-1977)

Item No. 75.03. Report by the Vice-Chancellor on important developments in the University since the last meeting.

Vice-Chancellor reported:

- 1) Prof. Satish Chandra, Chairman, UGC inaugurated the University Library Building on 29-1-1977. Prof. Satish Chandra was pleased to note that the construction

was completed ahead of schedule and that the actual cost of construction was less than the estimated cost. In the absence of the Pro-Vice Chancellor, owing to unforeseen reasons, his presidential address was read by the Vice-Chancellor.

- 2) Professor Satish Chandra, UGC Chairman during his visit to the University had discussions with the Heads of Departments of the University on 29-1-1977. They appraised him of the activities and programmes of the departments.

- 3) The Vice Chancellor visited the UGC at Delhi from 25th February to 1st March 1977 and had discussions with the Chairman and other members and officials of the Commission regarding the release of Grants to this University. The UGC released grants amounting to Rs. 12 lakhs and further grants amounting to about Rs. 3 lakhs are expected to be released during the current month.

- 4) A short term course on Administrative Law for senior officers of the Government was conducted in the Department of Law during 3-1-1977 to 31-1-1977 under the Directorship of Prof. A. T. Markose assisted by the members of the Law faculty.

- 5) A short term course was conducted in the State Institute of Public Administration at Trivandrum where in Dr. M. V. Pylee was the course Director and some faculty members also participated in the course.

- 6) A team of FAO headed by the Chief of FAO Mission in Colombo visited the University and had discussions with the Vice-Chancellor. They were looking for places where fishery training could be imparted, and enquired whether the Cochin University could be of assistance.

- 7) The Vice-Chancellor gave the inaugural address at the annual meeting of the Indian Rubber Manufacturers Research Association at Cochin on 10-2-1977.

8) Government have issued a Notification transferring the Engineering College, Trichur to the University under Section 60 (1) of the Cochin University Act. This should have the way for the release of an on account grant from the UGC for the Degree Course in Naval Architecture and Ship Building.

9) Shri. K. D. Zachariah, research scholar in the Law Department participated in the Inter University Seminar on National Integration - and he was awarded a prize.

10) The Vice-Chancellor participated in the conference of Vice-Chancellor's held at Coimbatore.

11) A workshop for writers in different languages oriented towards Hindi and another for translation were held in the Department of Hindi.

12) The State Government have constituted a Committee on Legal Studies with the Justice Balakrishnan Eradi as Chairman. They have been requested to keep the University informed of any advance action to be taken. Our University is represented there and the Dean of the Faculty of Law, Dr. A. T. Markose raised the question of introducing a course in Law of the seas and the creation of a post of Professor for the same. He was requested to prepare a detailed Note for discussion.

Item No. 75.05 Professor of Industrial Chemistry—Appointment of Dr. Paul A. Vatakancherry—Extension of Joining time.

The Syndicate considered the request of Dr. Paul A. Vatakancherry who has been appointed as Professor of

Industrial Chemistry that time may be given till the first week of June 1977 for joining duty as M/S Hindustan Levers Ltd., his present employer has agreed to relieve him by the end of May 1977 and that this is a notice period and he has to complete some important projects, along with the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Staff and Establishment.

Resolved that Dr. Paul A. Vatakancherry be given extension of time till the 1st week of June 1977 to join duty as Professor of Industrial Chemistry.

Item No. 75.06 Electrification and water supply and sanitary installation for the 'B' type quarters under construction—Revised estimates—approval - reg.

The Syndicate considered the revised estimate forwarded by the University Engineer amounting to Rs. 27,000/- and Rs. 45,000/- for electrification and water supply and sanitary installations respectively in respect of 'B' type quarters under construction along with the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on 'Works'.

Resolved that the revised estimate for electrification, water supply and sanitary installations forwarded by the University Engineer in respect of 'B' type quarters under construction be approved.

Item No. 75.07 Incorporation of a penal clause in Tender Forms—Recommendation of the Public Accounts Committee, 1969-70 of the Government of Kerala-reg.

The Syndicate considered the recommendation of the Public Accounts Committee that steps be taken to include a penal clause in every tender form which would enable the Government to penalise the contractor if he fails to

supply the materials according to tender rate along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Finance, Works and Purchase.

Resolved that the recommendation of the Public Accounts Committee 1969—70 regarding incorporation of a penal clause in the Tender forms be approved.

Item No. 75.08 Payment of honorarium to Shri. P. Balagangadhara Menon, Co-ordinator of the LL.M. course-reg.

The Syndicate considered the request of the Head of the Department of the Department of Law that Shri P. Balagangadhara Menon, Co-ordinator of the LL. M. course be paid an honorarium of Rs. 1,000/- for the year 1975—76 also as was sanctioned by the Syndicate on 10—1—1975 for 1974—75 along with the recommendation of the Committee on Finance, works & Purchase and 'Academic matters'

Resolved that the proposal for payment of Honorarium of Rs. 1000/- to Shri P. Balagangadhara Menon, Co-ordinator of the LL. M. course be approved subject to the condition that this arrangement may be terminated on appointment of regular staff.

The Syndicate considered the proposal for opening a new Head of Account viz. "13 (d) B. Plan-4 Contingencies-Equipment" in the current year's Budget along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Finance, Works & Purchase.

Resolved that a new head of account viz. "13. (d) B. Plan-4 Contingencies-Equipment", be opened in the current years budget and an amount of Rs. 7,000/- be

provided under this head by diverting the amount from "13-(a) B. Plan-4 Contingencies-Equipment" in the current year's budget.

Item No. 75.10. Post-Graduate Certificate Course in Translation and Secretarial drafting in Hindi-Continuation of the course in 1977.

The Syndicate considered the request of the Head of the Department of Hindi who is the Director of the Post Graduate Certificate Course in Translation and Secretarial drafting in Hindi that the two P. T. lecturers - Shri. K. A. Manoharan and Shri. Tom Varghese be permitted to continue as such for one more year for the present programme along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Academic matters:

Resolved that the Post Graduate Certificate Course in Translation and Secretarial Drafting in Hindi be continued during 1976—77 and that Shri. K. A. Manoharan and Shri. Tom Varghese be reappointed as P. T. lecturers during the period.

Item No. 75.11. Construction of a building for the Woman's Hostel at Thrikkakara—revised estimate—regarding.

The Syndicate considered the revised estimate forwarded by the University Engineer amounting to Rs. 8,43,287 for the completion, work and the reason for the enhancement of the estimate along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Works.

Resolved that the revised estimate in respect of items 2, 3 & 4 forwarded by the University Engineer be approved as indicated below:-

The Syndicate considered the revised estimate amounting to Rs. 31,000/- necessitated consequent to the revision of schedule of rates w. e. f. 1-7-1976 in respect of the Maintenance of the O. G. Lab (old) Building at the Marine Science Department along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Finance, Works & Purchase.

Resolved that the revised estimate amounted to Rs. 31,000/- for the maintenance of O. G. Lab Building (old) at the Marine Sciences Department be approved.

Item No. 75.13. Allotment of rooms in the University Hostels to persons other than students—Fixation of standard rent—amendment to decision—ratification-reg.

The Syndicate noted the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having issued an amendment to U. O. Communicating the decision of the Syndicate at its meeting on 9-10-1976 that rent at Rs. 30/- p. m. be recovered from the teachers for the rooms in the Hostel at Trikkakara and Ernakulam up to 1-7-1976 to the effect that no refund or recovery of the difference between the actual monthly rent collected from the non-student occupants of the University Hostel at Ernakulam prior to 1-7-1976 and the rate of Rs. 30/- p. m. will be made.

Item No. 75.17. Award of Doctor of Science degree to Dr. R. Viswanathan Unnithan under the Faculty of Marine Sciences.

The Syndicate considered the individual reports of the examiners, consolidated report of the Chairman and the remark of Dean, Faculty of Marine Sciences in respect of the evaluation of the published work "Studies on Monogenetic Trematodes" submitted by Dr. R. Viswanathan Unnithan for the award of D. Sc. degree.

Resolved that Dr. R. Viswanathan Unnithan be awarded the degree of Doctor of Science under the Faculty of Marine Sciences for his published works "Studies on Monogenetic Trematodes".

Item No. 75.18. Write off of unserviceable articles of the Department of Physics-reg.

The Syndicate considered the request that sanction be given to write off certain unserviceable articles along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Finance, Works & Purchase.

Mohandas Lecturer that they be recognised as Supervising Teacher in their field of specialisation under the Faculty of Marine Sciences to Supervise research leading to the award of Ph. D. along with the recommendation of the Dean, Faculty of Marine Sciences and the Standing Committee on Academic matters.

Resolved that Dr. D. Chandramohan, Reader in Microbiology, Dr. P. G. Kurup, Reader in Physical Oceanography and Dr. A. Mohandas, Lecturer be recognised as Supervising Teachers in the Faculty of Marine Sciences.

Item No. 75.20. Engineering Department—Maintenance of Bus—Diversion of fund—ratification - reg.

The Syndicate noted the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having additionally provided a sum of Rs. 22,000/- under the Head '8 Engg. Department A. Non-Plan—4—Contingencies—6. Maintenance of Bus by diverting the same amount from the same major Head viz. Rs. 6000/-

from 4 Contingencies—4 Electricity Charges, Rs. 5000/- from 4 Contingencies—1. Pay of contingent employees and Rs. 11,000/- from 1) Pay of Officers in the current year's budget.

Resolved that the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor be ratified.

Item No. 75. 21. Implementation of ratio of Assistants and Typist/Stenographers—review of the existing practice - reg.

The Syndicate considered the proposal for reviewing the existing practice of implementing ratio among the Assistance and Typists/Stenographers in the University along with the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate of Staff and establishment.

Resolved that the procedure prescribed by the Government in the matter of maintenance of ratio of Typists/Stenographers and Assistants be adopted in modification of the Syndicate decision dated 9—3—1973.

Resolved further that the date of creation of the posts be taken as the date on which the Syndicate decides to create the posts.

The Syndicate considered the question of sponsoring the candidature of Shri. T. M. Sankaran, Lecturer, Department of Marine Sciences for Commonwealth Scholarship offered by UK (and Canada) for 1977 along with the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Academic matters.

Resolved that Shri. T. M. Sankaran be sponsored for the above fellowship and that he be granted leave with full pay and allowances for the period of fellowship.

The Syndicate considered whether the reimbursement of the fee paid for the obligatory departmental test by the Assistants at the rate of Rs. 3/- per paper be reduced from two to one chance for each test whether the officer appears for the test in full or for one or more parts of the test subject to the condition that for this purpose the mere fact of having applied for a test will be taken to mean that the candidate has appeared for the test and that this will apply to all obligatory Departmental Tests notified by the Kerala Public Service Commission after 25—1—1976. along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Staff and Establishment.

Resolved that the Government Orders No. G. O. MS No. 26/76 PD dated 25—1—1976 and G. O. MS. No. 336/PD dated 6—11—1968 be adopted.

Item No. 75.24. Promotion of a L. D. Typist/Stenographer in a leave vacancy—consideration of.

The Syndicate considered the proposal for filling up a maternity leave vacancy of Smt. Vally Ammal, U. D. Typist/ Stenographer by promoting the senior most L. D. Typist/Stenographer viz. Smt. K. Sreedevi Amma in relaxation of the economy measures along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Staff and Establishment.

Resolved that the leave vacancy of U. D. Typist/Stenographer be filled up by promoting the senior most L. D. Typist/Stenographer in relaxation of the economy measures.

The Syndicate considered the proposal for starting M. Sc. course in Mathematics along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Academic Matters.

Resolved that the M. Sc. Course in Mathematics be started as proposed and the fees be tentatively fixed at Rs. 200/- per Semester subject to unification of the fees for all courses.

Item No. 75.27 Registration of candidates for part-time research degrees in various Faculties.

The Syndicate considered the applications for part-time research in respect of M/s. N. E. Cheriyan Kunju, Statistical Officer, Cardamom Board and P. K. Somasekharan Unni, Lecturer, Sree Sankara College, Kalady and examined whether (1) the teachers working in colleges affiliated to Kerala University and whose locations are within the jurisdiction of this University may be treated as teachers recognised by this University for the purpose of registration for part-time research, (2) the cases in which the normal place of employment of candidate are outside the jurisdiction may be considered on the strength of the recommendation of the Guide agreeir g to give effective supervision for the purpose of Regulation

I (iii), and (3) the positions of Chairman, Publicity Officer, Statistical Officer, Marketing Manager etc. of the institutions mentioned above can be considered as research staff for the purpose of registration for Ph. D. and if so the respective institutions are to be recognised as recognised institutions under the Faculty of Social Sciences as per Regulations for recognition of institutions.

Deferred for consideration after the revision of Regulations for Research Degrees.

Item No. 75.28 Recommendations of the Boards of appointments.

The Syndicate considered the recommendations of the Boards of Appointment constituted for selection of candidates for appointment to the various teaching posts in the University together with the connected records.

Resolved that the recommendations of the various Boards of Appointment be approved.

Resolved further that:

1) Dr. L. Suneetha Bai, Technical Assistant, Department of Hindi be appointed as Lecturer in Hindi, against the vacant Non-Plan post, on an initial pay of Rs. 600/- in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-800-50-1100-50/2-1250.

2) Dr. S. Shajahan, Beema Manzil, Chalakodu, Punalur be appointed as Lecturer in Hindi in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-800-50-1100-50/2-1250, against the post of lecturer sanctioned by the U. G. C. for the V Plan.

3) Shri. K. N. Chandrasekharan Pillai, T. C. 19, Gwyer Hall, University of Delhi be appointed as Lecturer in Law (with specialisation in criminal Law) on an initial pay of Rs. 680/- in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-800-50-1100-50/2-1250, against one post of lecturer sanctioned by the U. G. C. for the V Plan.

4) Shri. N. S. Chandrasekharan, Assistant Sales Tax Officer (Law), Office of the Deputy Commissioner (Law) Board of Revenue (Taxes) Cochin be appointed as Lecturer in Law (with specialisation in Labour Law), in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-800-1100-50/2-1250, against the second post of lecturer sanctioned by the U. G. C. for the V Plan.

Resolved also that the initial pay in respect of Dr. S. Shajahan and Shri. N. S. Chandrasekharan be fixed by the Vice-Chancellor protecting the last pay drawn by these candidates in their respective institutions.

Resolved that the Head of the Department of Russian, Calicut University be nominated to the Board of Studies in Foreign Languages.

Item No. 75.31 Additional Fund for the purchase of Books and periodicals.

The Syndicate considered the proposal whether an amount of Rs. 50,000/- be additionally provided under the Head "13 (a) Biological Oceanography Plan—4—Contingencies (1) Books and Periodicals" by diverting the same amount from the Head "9 Works B Plan—3. Hostels' x) Non Teaching Staff" in the current year's budget.

Resolved that the diversion of funds as proposed be sanctioned.

Resolved further that difference, if any, be paid to Veekshnam Daily on the Government fixing the rate for them.
