Item No 352. 01 : Report of action taken up on the decisions of the Syndicate meeting held on 22nd June 1994. (347th).

Resolved that the report of action taken on the decisions of the Syndicate at its meeting held on 22nd June 1994 be noted.

Item No. 352. 02 : Confirmation of the Minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 20-10-1994 (351st).

Resolved that the minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate held on 20-10-1994 be confirmed subject to the amendment that the words ' (full-time)' occurring in the title, preamble and in the resolution under item 351. 29 be corrected as (part-time)'.

Before the other items on the Agenda could be taken up for consideration, certain members invited the attention of the Chairman to the decision of the Syndicate taken at its meeting held on 20-10-1994 that suitable action may be taken against the persons who barged into the Syndicate room at its meeting held on 20-10-1994. Having considered the matter, it was resolved that:

(a) The Registrar be asked to complete the inquiry within 15 days.

(b) Those persons who are the students of the University and barged into the Syndicate room be expelled from the rolls of the University immediately and complaints be lodged with the Police against the other persons who are not students of the University.

Thereupon, Shri S. Sarma, MLA stated that it was no proper on the part of the Vice Chancellor in having written against him to the Governor of Kerala and the Speaker, Legislative Assembly about the Press Conference held in the Administrative Office. He has also stated that the Syndicate meetings should have been held at least once in a month according to the provisions in the Statutes.

The Vice-Chancellor agreed to ascertain opinion from legal experts regarding the provisions of the Statutes relating to convening of the Syndicate meeting, as the present clause is smenble to different interpretations.

Before transacting item No, 352. 03 in the Agenda, certain members wanted to consider item No 352. 03 first relating to filing of appeal petition in the Supreme Court of India against the judgement of the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala. At this juncture, the Chairman ruled that it was only appropriate that the business of the meeting was transacted according to the Agenda of the meeting. Not satisfied with the ruling of the Chairman, M/s. P. Subramonia Iyer, B. Raghavan, Binoy Viswom, S. Sarma and Johnson P. John walked-out of the meeting, some of them using unprintable language as they made their exit. As the walk-out of the above members resulted in lack of quorum fixed for the meeting of the Syndicate, the remaining members dispersed at 12. 15 without transacting the items on the Agenda.
